#### [1] Announcement

Bridgend Automobile Club will organise Clubmans Production Car Autotests on the dates shown above at Llandow, CF71 7PY.

#### [2] Jurisdiction

This meeting will be held under the General Regulations of Motorsport UK (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), and these Supplementary Regulations.

## [3] Permits

#### [4] Eligibility

The event is open to all fully-elected members of Bridgend Automobile Club and the following invited clubs:

Maesteg MC

Kidwelly MC

Swansea MC

Teifi Valley MC

HRCR (Historic Rally Car Register)

All entrants must produce a relevant and valid Club membership card and valid RS Clubman license.

All cars and drivers must adhere to the drivers briefing, Bridgend Automobile Club rules and the applicable rules of MotorsportUK.

# [5] Championships

The event is a round of Bridgend Automobile Club championship.

# [6] Scrutineering/Programme

Scrutineering starts at 9:15 on the day of the event at Llandow.

# [7] Event Start

The event will start at 10:00

Nature of Start: Countdown.

Handicapping Details: N/A

Any competitor not signed on by 10:00 may be excluded.

# [8] Description of Event

The event is held on private land and will comprise of timed tests around a prescribed course. The number of runs will depend on the number of entrants and is usually 6 runs. The slowest run is normally dropped from the results.

The length of the course is variable depending on the course layout on the day of the event.

The route will be described at the drivers briefing prior to the start time

## [9] Vehicles Starting Positions

The vehicles will start in the order at which they arrive at the start line

#### [10] Practicing Requirements

Practicing will not be permitted.

# [11] Identification

Identification numbers will not be required by the organisers.

# [12] Pits Area

Only competing cars and support vehicles will be allowed in the venue. Spectators cars are not allowed in the venue.

# [13] Judges of Fact

All organisers signed on as marshals will be judges of fact and observe driving standards.

# [14] Television Coverage

There will be no television coverage although still photographs and videos may be taken by spectators which may be published on social media.

## [15] Awards

Awards will be presented as follows: -

The event results will count towards the various championships as described on the Club website.

## [16] Entries

The maximum entry for the meeting is 25 and the minimum is 10. Should any of the above figures not be reached, the organisers have the right to amalgamate classes or cancel the event.

Entries are selected on a first come first served basis.

# [17] Entry List

The entry list opens at the beginning of the month in which the event is being held and closes finally on the Saturday prior to the event at noon.

Entries must be applied for online using the link advertised on the Club Facebook page

# 18] Entry Fee/Refunds

The entry fee is £25. All entries must be made on the official form and be accompanied by the entry fee being transferred to the Club account.

Entries fees may be carried over to the next event if there is a failure to compete as long as a reasonable reason is provided.

#### [19] Refusal of Entries

The Club reserves the right to refuse an entry if there is reasonable cause.

## [20] Additional Entry Information

The online entry form must be completed in full or the entry will be rejected.

## [21] Nomination of Drivers

All drivers and co-drivers must complete the online entry form.

#### [22] Postponement/Cancellation

Should the event be cancelled due to lack of entries or for any other reason entrants will be notified by email and a notice posted on the Club Facebook page.
