BAC Treasurers Report

1. Aldermore Savings Bond Account – we have £10,000 invested for 1 year @ 4.27% AER to mature on 12/12/24. Interest is being paid monthly directly into our Lloyds bank account.

From the information provided I have estimated the charges would amount to about £55 / year. I will investigate other banks but would imagine they will all either have a similar charging policy or be bringing one in at a later date.
